## The Value of Armed Populations

Ultimately wars and revolutions are not won by defeating the opponent's army or overthrowing a government. These struggles are only decided when one side defeats the others' population. Armies can only control the real-estate they stand on and rebels can only occupy a few buildings, but the mass of a nation always belongs to the people. This truth has been proven over and over again through history.

- The Soviet Union collapsed when the population finally became totally disaffected with the communist regime and refused to comply. They didn't even need to resort to armed violence to prevail.
- In 1776 the British, with the most powerful army in the world, eventually had to recognize the independence of its North American colonies, simply because the masses there no longer would assent to being governed by them.
- The British, the Russians and the United States, all failed to win in

Afghanistan, because the culture and population simply would not comply.

- The term guerilla and guerilla warfare originated in Spain as the population rose up against Napoleon in 1810. The need to constantly fight in Spain drew strength from his other campaigns and contributed to his eventual down-fall in Russia.
- The United States was unable to win wars in Vietnam, Afghanistan, and Iran in spite of defeating the enemy's armies, because the populations were not supportive of a foreign invader, no matter how benevolent.

Opposite examples also exist where populations were disarmed, subjugated, and culturally inclined to be obedient.

- In spite of Nazi ideological indoctrination Germany surrendered without much civilian resistance when the state declared a surrender, because (1) the fascists had (as always) disarmed the population, and (2) Germans had a cultural tradition of obedience.

- The Japanese only surrendered when the Emperor told them it was over. American understanding of Japanese culture of obedience, established a policy of not bombing the palace or letting the Emperor come to harm, just for this reason. Of course Japan has never permitted civilians to be armed.
- In the early days of World War Two there was a real possibility that Germany would invade England. The long history of English obedience to a king and being unarmed, suddenly left them helpless before an invader. The people were willing to resist, but had nothing to fight with. Americans sent over thousands of guns, and tons of ammunition for their Home Guard. Of course these weapons were never left to the people after the war.

Examples of the deterrent effects of potential resistance and militia (by any name) organizations are easy to find.

- Recently Ukrainians began training civilians to fight the Russians in anticipation of the invasion. Ukrainian militias were seen training in the snow lead by older veterans. While it was obvious that the Ukrainian Army alone could not stop the massive Russian forces on their borders, the combination of a robust defense by the Ukrainian Army combined with a massive civilian resistance even behind Russian lines, stalled the overwhelming might of Russian armor and manpower.
- During the Cold War, the popularity of the slogan "Better Dead than Red" and the rise of Survivalism and doomsday preparedness was said to have frightened the USSR and convinced them that starting a conventional war

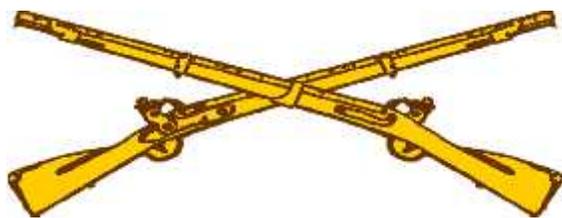
could lead to a nuclear exchange that America was willing to endure. .

- The creation of the British Home Guard, ready to fight with pitchforks and old rifles had a deterrent effect on Hitler's plans to invade the island in 1940.

While anti-gun politicians and the media decry the need for "military style" weapons in the hands of the public and often point out that armed civilians cannot stand against a trained army with artillery, tanks, and aircraft, this is precisely what happened over-and-over again in past and recent times. As Japan's Admiral Yamamoto told General Tojo before World War Two, "never invade America, there will be a rifle behind every blade of grass". **What no one in the gun debate likes to talk about is the obvious fact that the second amendment to the US constitution was specifically intended to preserve the right to possess "military style" firearms for the purpose of resisting foreign and domestic threats to life and freedom.** Nowhere in the amendment is criminal self-defense, or hunting mentioned. The reference to a "well-regulated militia" in the text is often misinterpreted to imply that arms are only to be had by those in a government "regulated" organization, but the word "regulated" in 1776 meant trained and organized, not controlled as the word is used today. While there are many formally organized militia groups with varying levels of responsibility and capability, the historic term militia implies all of the population organized or not, In fact modern technology makes formal organizations much more vulnerable to observation and interdiction by both foreign and domestic oppression. A generally trained and

equipped public that has the potential for protracted resistance or unorganized uprisings, serves as a powerful, and unpredictable force in preventing invasion, coups, or insurrections. This may explain why the United States has the world's oldest government. The armed citizen and would-be militia member may never fire a shot, but their existence serves as a powerful deterrent. Certainly armed civilians cannot stop a modern army with all of its technology and hardware, but they can make victory impossible. This is really what is at stake in America today and a critical part of survival reality.

The enemies' of freedom and self-reliance know that they cannot defeat an armed and united population, so they actively seek to defeat the American people, by dividing, and confusing us. Russia and China are masters of disinformation, and have weaponized the internet and social media to spread baseless conspiracy theories, hate, and distrust. If they can divide the people they can conquer the people. The Third World War has been going on for decades, and we are losing because both the extreme left and the extreme right fall for the enemies divisive tactics. As Ben Franklin put it, "we must all hang together or we will surely hang separately".

## Survival in the Ukrain

*Just before the invasion the following text was in an article from Associated Press about Ukrainians preparing to fight the Russians.*

*KHARKIV, Ukraine – "The table tennis coach, the dentist, and the firebrand nationalist have little in common except the desire to defend their hometown", "If Russia invades, some of Kharkiv's 1 million people stand ready to abandon their civilian lives and wage a guerrilla campaign against one of the world's greatest military powers. The article goes on to explain how families plan to evacuate their children and then use whatever weapons they have to resist. They already have stocks of water, food, and medical supplies for survival. US intelligence officers were quoted as saying, "The Russians, want to destroy Ukraine's combat forces. They don't want to be in a position where they have to occupy ground, where they have to deal with civilians, where they have to deal with an insurgency". Once again proof that the potential of armed civilians is the ultimate defense of liberty in any nation, just as the authors of the constitution intended.*

### **Live Free USA 52<sup>nd</sup>\* Annual Meeting Report**

Mark Smith the President of Live Free USA opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. Jim Jones made a brief report on the organizations status and operations through the past two years. Marie Jones the Treasurer reported that the organization started 2021 with \$17,090.17 and ended with \$18,065.08. Income totaled \$5,720.56, and expense totaled \$4,746.02. While membership declined expense also declined and we received a few significant contributions. Mark Smith presented Outstanding Service Awards to Morgan Nunan for building our new website, and to Jeff Agan for both helping secure contributions and manning gun show tables.

**The following resolution was adopted by vote**

*“Whereas the Ukrainian people have demonstrated the highest level of bravery and determination to survive and stay free in the face of overwhelming hazards and brutality, Live Free USA hereby resolves to support and recognize the heroic citizens of the free Ukraine in their continued struggle for life and freedom”.*

*Adopted March 26<sup>th</sup> 2022*

A few voiced objections that this was a political position, but most agreed that as Live Free USA” we should support people who are actually engaged in a struggle for their lives and freedoms, regardless of politics.

**Elections**

The members agreed that there were no other candidates for each of the offices beyond those listed by the nominating committee so after requesting if there were any other candidates, a single vote elected

all of the listed officers with no objections. Since all of the officers terms had expired this installed eleven new officers, with just one office unfilled. This reestablishes the three year rotation system so that only four terms expire each year going forward. It is notable that this is the first time in a decade that we have elected almost a full slate of dedicated and qualified officers.

**Three Amendments to the Bylaws were approved by Vote**

- The first requires that Directors self-assign or be assigned task with 30 days of being elected and are required to make reports at annual meetings.
- The second added the specifications for a Chapter / Affiliations Coordinator to the Directors tasks
- The third amendment adopted provided for the extension of officers terms and the replacement of officers in the event that an emergency situation precludes having an Annual Meeting or vote. This basically certifies what we did to continue operations throughout the pandemic.

Other Business included details of technical issues with the website, and with planning for Camp Independence 2022. The meeting was adjourned, and these discussions continued at the first Board of Directors meeting immediately afterward. The energy level and ideas put forth throughout this meeting bodes well for our future.

## Four Tools for Every Sheep Dog – Pt 2

Four weapons may seem excessive to some, but remember that guns can jam or run out of bullets. Also, less-than-lethal force may be all you need, depending upon the situation.

- 1. An impact weapon.** When you are walking from your car to the grocery store, you are probably not going to have your gun in your hand – that would be illegal in many states (called “flourishing”) but you can have your car keys on a Persuader™ Baton. If it is in your hand, the ‘21’ Rule’ doesn’t apply, i.e., you can react immediately to an attack, and cause serious damage to a wolf. A handheld flashlight (like the SureFire™ line) is another good impact weapon, especially at night where it has the ability to temporarily blind the wolf, especially if it has 300+ lumens of light. (If your state/local laws allow it, an expandable baton like the ASP™ is the BEST impact weapon.)
- 2. Pepper spray.** Other than a firearm, nothing else has the “reach” besides OC. But remember this advice: “Shoot and move” when you use OC. The wolf

may have glasses on, be high on drugs, be mentally ill or both. There is no guarantee that a blast of OC is going to stop him/her, i.e., they may be injured to pain. Real-life examples from the police show that TASERS and even multiple gun-shot wounds sometimes fail to stop wolves. Two good on-line sources of OC:

NOTE: In Missouri, OC is not considered a “weapon”. Check your state laws.

- 3. A tactical pocket knife that meets your state laws** – in Missouri the maximum blade length is 4”. Many knife manufacturers make the blades 3 and 7/8” long to meet state laws. You are more likely to use your knife to cut open a box, or to cut a seat belt in an emergency, but it is still a last-ditch tool to have handy. But I always remember this advice written by Massad Ayoob: *“Yes, you may well kill your attacker with your knife, but he may die 3 hours after he had killed you with his knife”.*
- 4. One or two firearms.** There have been thousands of books and articles written about CCW, so I have only three points to add: a) The gun must quickly accessible; that’s why I like my *Sneaky Pete Holster*. Contrary to what the fashion industry tells us, people do not examine every article of clothing we wear. I wear my *Sneaky Pete* at work and in social situations, and no one notices it. When we greet people we look at their face, not their belt! b) However, you carry your firearm, make sure it is being kept clean. It is tempting to throw a snubbie into coat or pants pocket, but most pockets contain coins,

“fuzz”, and other contaminants. For snubbies, DeSantis makes a nice “sticky” holster that will stay in your pocket when the gun is drawn. c) Carry extra ammunition! I have a magazine in the gun plus two extra magazines. In a stressful situation, we are likely to miss and/or use more ammo than we had planned. Lastly, you can always carry a shotgun or rifle in the trunk of your vehicle for extra protection.

### Emergency Medical Information

At a recent first aid class/meeting the subject of having complete personal medical information available for responding medical personnel was discussed. I usually include a recommendation that everyone carry some kind of card with their emergency contact information, blood type, medical conditions, allergies, and medications. If you are injured or seriously ill you may be unconscious or unable to provide this information verbally. It is extremely difficult and dangerous for medics and doctors to provide care and medication without this information. Having this information written down and available could save your life. Years ago Live Free distributed cards like the one below at our events and first aid classes, and we may print these up again on bright orange cardstock, but you can use the format below to make your own cards. Just print this on heavy-duty colored paper and fold in the center.

### Cozii Tourniquits

I thought I would update my collection of tourniquets so I could do more classes this year. I have several older versions of CAT tourniquets with the older locking loops. When I went on line for tourniquets there were lots of ads for these Cozii™ versions. They came in two packs, four packs, and larger quantities. I bought a two pack from Amazon for \$15.00. I now know that these are (as most stuff is) made in China. I find it interesting that the search engine steered me to them. China has so much influence that they control our news, what we see, and what we buy! If you have ever tried to apply an older style tourniquet to yourself you know it can be difficult, to impossible if the injury is to either arm, You have to do it onehanded and the tourniquet tends to slip around when you can't hold it in place with the other hand. The Cozii tourniquet is a single-use, disposable device that uses an “adhesive”, actually Velcro™ to hold it in places while you

tighten it. It's a great idea. I ordered two, and used one to practice with. The instructions are more difficult than the actual application. The arrogant Chinese were too cheap to pay an English speaking person to write the instructions. The text of the instructions is more humorous than useful. Phraseology such as "sheath it to the wound closed to the heart" or "stick tight reversely" are part of the seven step instructions. The use of the term "adhesive" in place of Velcro makes you expect a one-time, glue surface, but the Velcro can be used over and over in practice. The small, white "Time:" label proved a place write the time you applied the tourniquet, an important step for medics. Application is actually simple, fast and can be done with one hand. The idea of a one-handed tourniquet is sound, but. I do hope our military and police are using an American made version.



Compact tourniquet. Note the rod used to tighten the device and the white strip for writing the application time.



Application to the arm using just the other hand was fast and easy. There is sufficient strap to wrap around upper arm or upper thigh as needed.

# American Preparedness Checklist

## Self-reliant families are the foundation of a safe and free society

This checklist contains the minimum and essential requirements for surviving the most probable on hazardous situations that the average citizen may face. Preparedness is a journey not a destination and you should continue beyond these requirement to achieve greater self-reliance. Everyone has different needs and capabilities based on location, health, budget, and capabilities, so the detail of how to achieve these goals is not specified here. More information and lists can be obtained from the Live Free USA website at [www.americansurvivor.org](http://www.americansurvivor.org).

**Home Emergency Preparedness:** Does your home have all of the following preparedness items?

- Two gallons of stored water per person per day for at least ten days [ ]
- Enough food to provide 2000 calories per person per day for at least 30 days [ ]
- Solar power lanterns, flashlight, candles, and oil lamps to provide light for 10-20 days [ ]
- A safe method of providing heat for one room at least ten days [ ]
- At least two gallons of household bleach for sanitation and water purification [ ]
- A camp toilet, extra toilet paper and plastic bags [ ]
- Clothing and sleeping bags for sustained winter survival [ ]
- At least two large (size 10) ABC fire extinguishers [ ]
- Solar, crank, and battery powered emergency AM/FM/WX radio [ ]
- One or two burner camp stove and plenty of LP gas cylinders [ ]
- A well-stocked first aid kit [ ]
- At least one defense firearm, handgun, shotgun, or rifle with 100 rounds of ammunition [ ]
- Items kept in or on your nightstand for immediate access if a fire, home invasion or other emergency develops while you are asleep including your, cellphone, wallet, car keys, flashlight, weapon, escape tool, and whistle [ ]
- Plans for family emergencies including, medical emergencies, storms, fire, civil disorder, pandemics, home invasion, and evacuation [ ]

**Everyday Emergency Preparedness:** Do you carry what you need and are you prepared to survive emergencies that develop while you are away from home?

- Small pocket knife or multi-tool [ ] Matches, lighter, or magnesium stick [ ]  
Miniature flashlight [ ] Folding N95 respirator [ ] Cloth bandana [ ]
- If you are over fifty, it is recommend that you always carry a few aspirin tablets, to take in the event of a heart attack. Taken immediately it can save your life [ ]

**Evacuation Preparedness:** Is every member of your family prepared to survive and evacuate to a safer location immediately if necessary by having the following?

- An appropriately sized evacuation pack sufficient to provide filtered air, purified water, basic warmth and shelter, sufficient food, basic first aid, self-protection, and other life essentials for at least three days without help [ ]
- All essential documents (e.g. identification, insurance, deed, medical data, etc.) packaged and ready to take with you in an emergency [ ]
- An established destination and/or rendezvous point away from your home that every family member knows [ ]

**Street and Road Preparedness:** Are you prepared for emergencies when you are away from home by having the following?

- An appropriate weapon such as a firearm (preferred), or pepper spray to defend yourself against street crime [ ]
- A small get home pack of essential supplies to survive an immediate emergency and travel to home or other safe location on foot if necessary [ ]
- A well-equipped vehicle emergency kit including, flairs, flashlight, first aid kit, water, food, blankets, jumper cables, fire extinguisher and other supplies [ ]
- Plans for surviving a carjacking, active shooter, stranded in storm, injury, and other potential away from home emergencies [ ]

**Child and Adolescent Emergency Preparedness:** Are your children prepared, trained and involved in you safety and preparedness plans by the following actions?

- Each child has age and school appropriate survival items in his or her pack such as a whistle, respirator, first aid kit, emergency food, Mylar blanket, etc. [ ]
- Each child has been trained in what to do for active shooter, attempted abduction, assault, storms, and other hazardous situations [ ]
- Each child has been trained and has practiced for home emergencies such as home fire, home invasion, medical emergencies (e.g. CPR, blood stop), and evacuation.
- Each child has been informed of the emergency rendezvous point in case of separation in a disaster [ ]
- As children get older they are given increased emergency training and responsibilities [ ]
